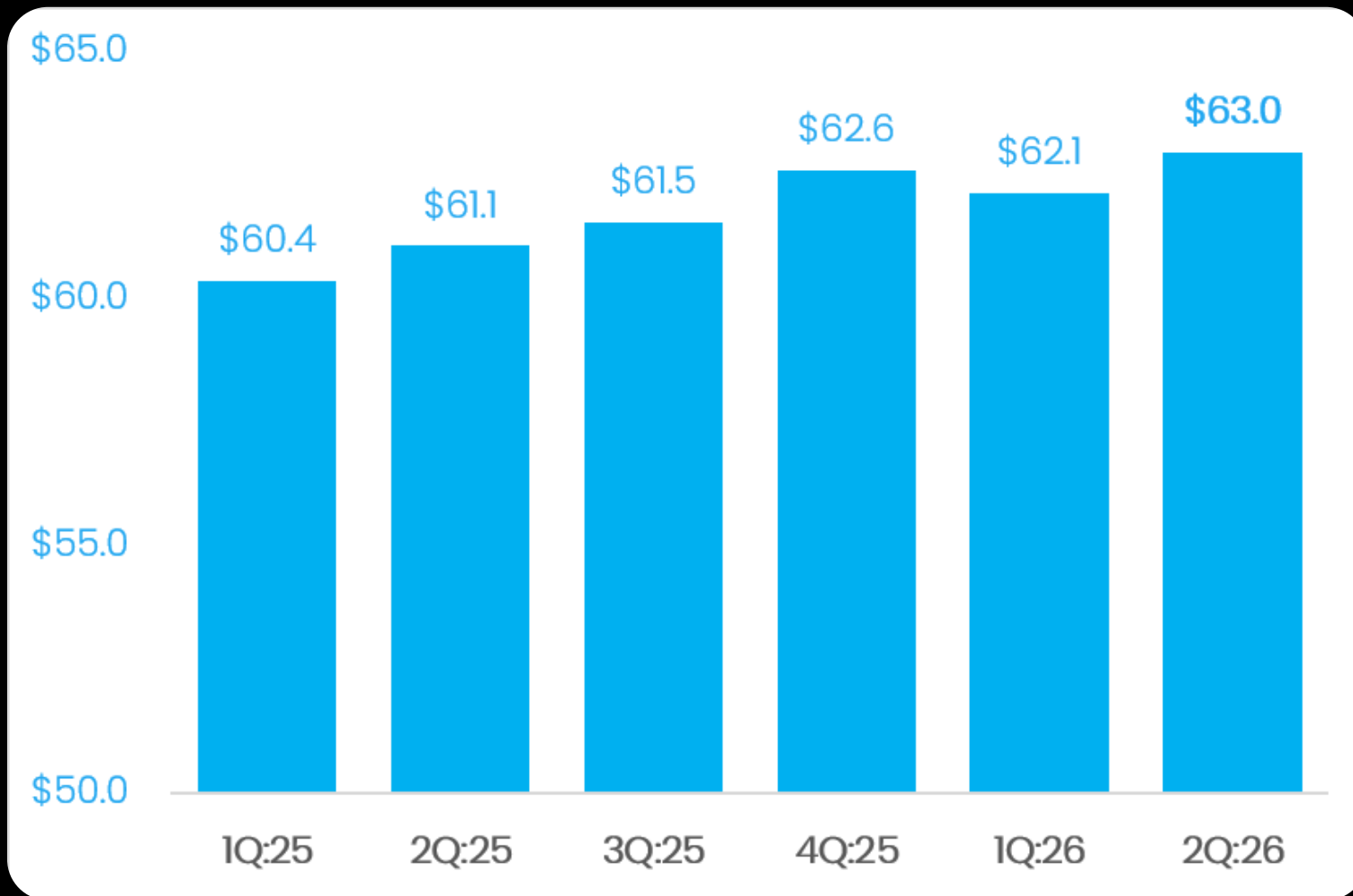

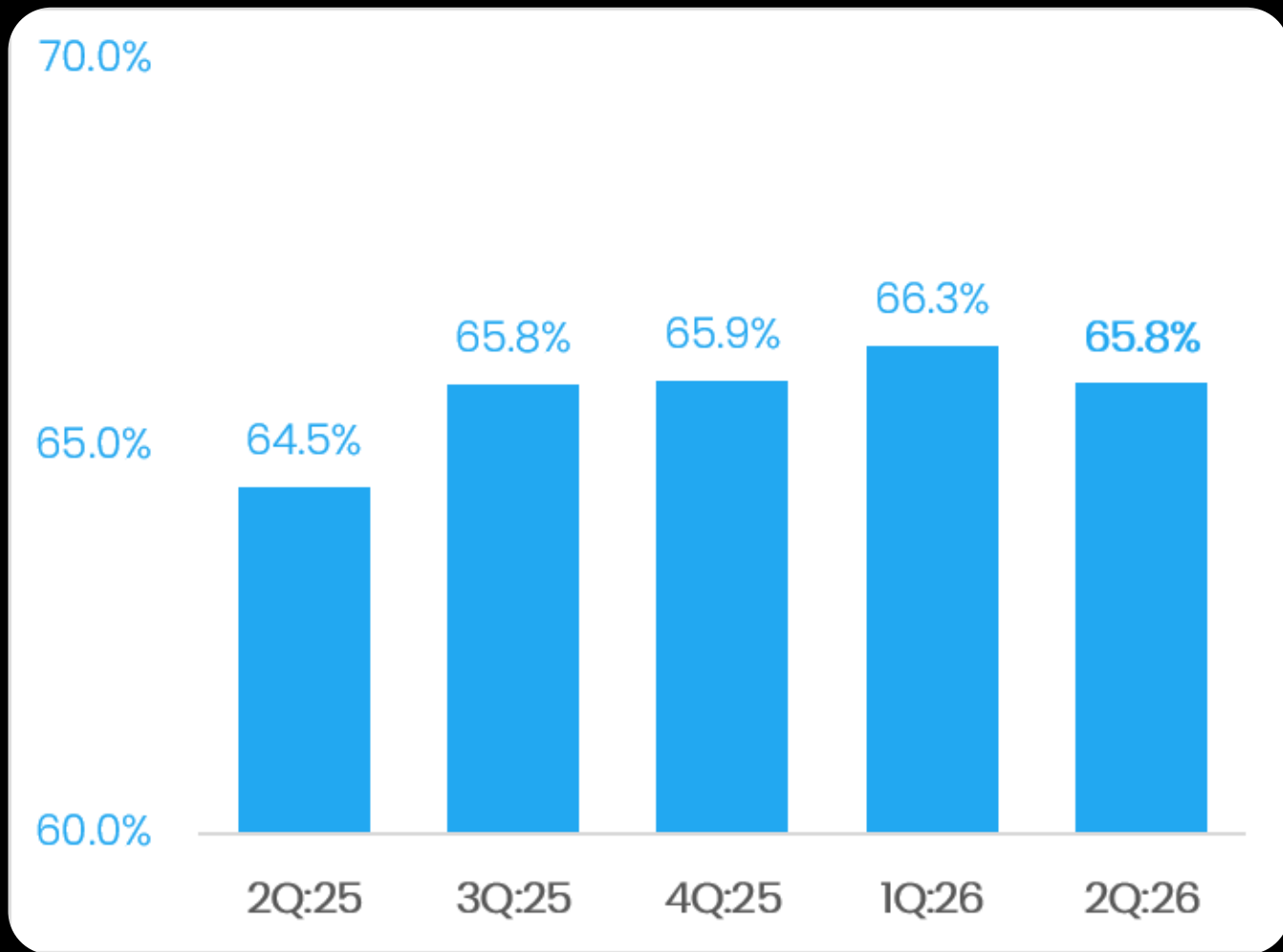

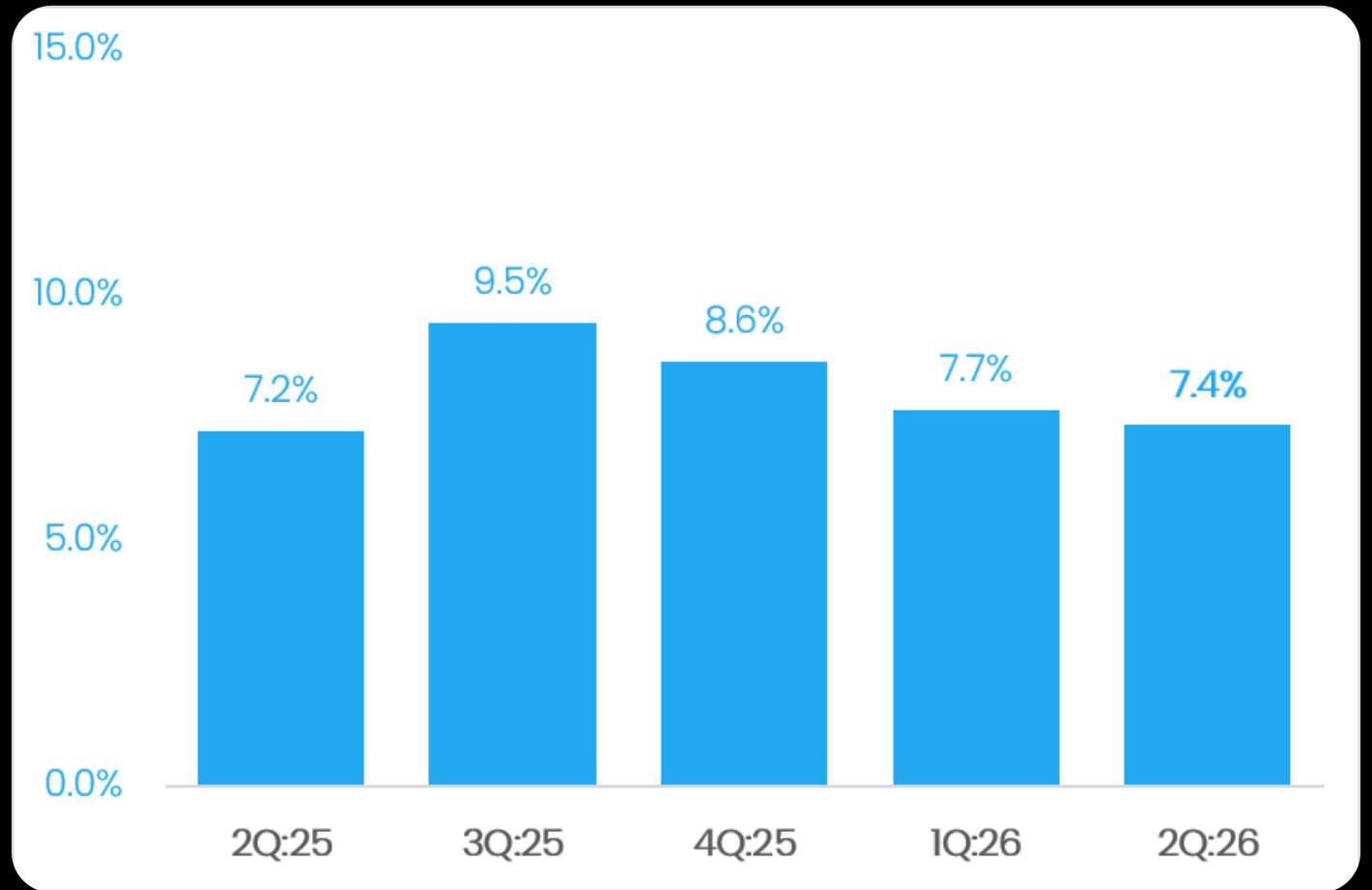
Revenues
